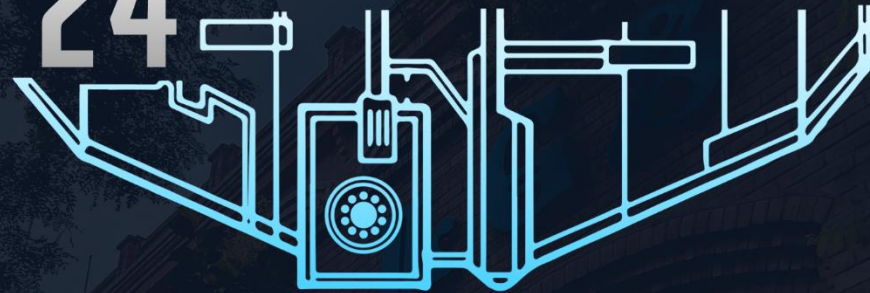

Round 1:

Delegate Cap: 3

Trivia Time! For round 1, delegates will be tested and tried on their basic knowledge of the subject. This knowledge may include, but is not limited to; key terms, psychological concepts, famous experiments, and even historical figures.

The round will follow a buzzer round format, with multiple teams per round. The questions will be asked in an MCQ format.

This round will be an elimination round

Round 2:

Delegate Cap: 3

All qualifying teams will be given case studies to decipher, they'll be asked to remember certain specific details for the given experiments before being quizzed by a panel of judges on parts of it which may include: key experimental details, specific experimental procedures and any questions of explaining symptoms in cases where the case study has any mental disorders.

This round will be an elimination round.

Round 3:

Delegate Cap: 5

All qualifying teams will be given a case study/topic to research a day in advance. They'll have to present the given topic along with any symptoms of the disorder, treatments, associated complications, and other information which the category heads will detail in advance.

The round will work in a way where the audience will get to question the other teams on their presentations as well as a panel of judges who will score and question presenting teams.

A document containing more information about this round will be distributed before this round.
